HOME FOUNDATION AWARDS \$144,000 FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Oregon Realtors Give out Grants to Organizations Across the State

SALEM, OR – The HOME Foundation, the charitable arm of the Oregon Association of Realtors, just awarded \$144,000 to 27 community nonprofit organizations dedicated to affordable housing throughout the state of Oregon. This brings the total grants awarded to over \$750,000 since the program's inception in 2004.

The HOME Foundation is a nonprofit corporation providing financial resources to create, expand, and encourage homeownership opportunities for Oregonians at or below local median income. Money raised comes directly from member Realtors and industry affiliates, who reach deep into their pockets each year to help their fellow Oregonians.
